Library cards will allow your students to access library databases, eBooks, eAudiobooks, and, of course, our large range of library materials!

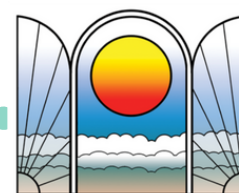


## FALL VISITS
