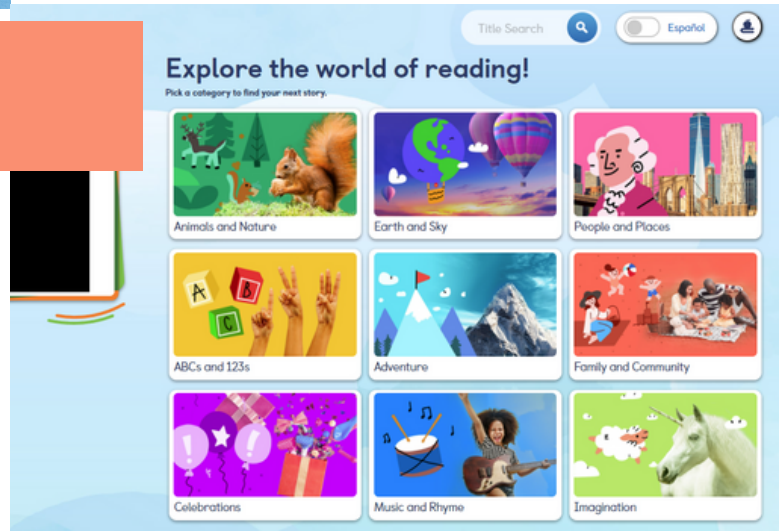
BOOKFLIX

LIBRARY CARDS

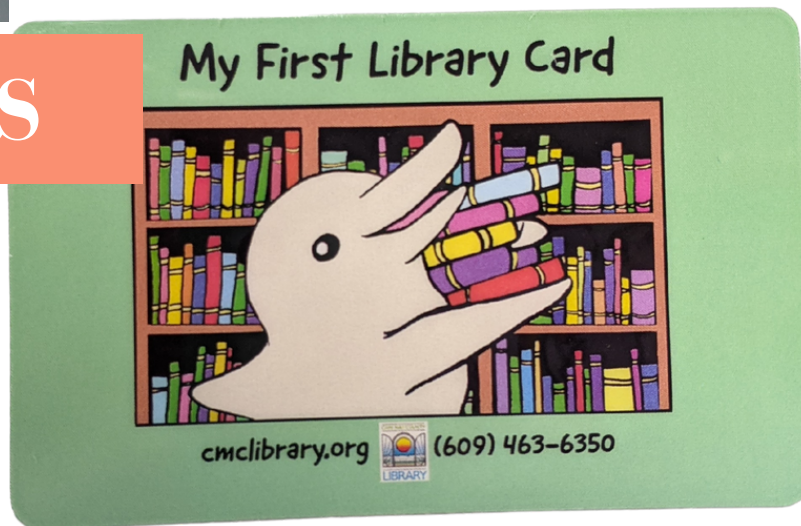
Students can get new library cards by having their caregivers fill out our online form:

Library cards will allow your students to access library databases, eBooks, eAudiobooks, and, of course, our large range of library materials!



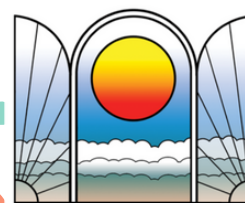
SPRING CHALLENGE
