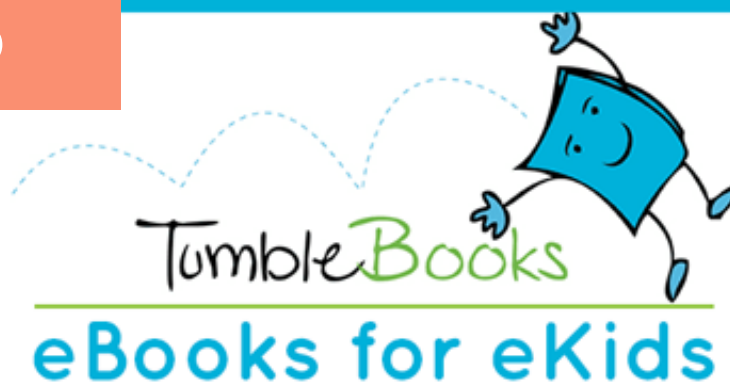
SUMMER READING

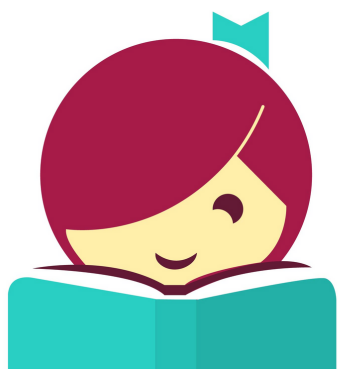

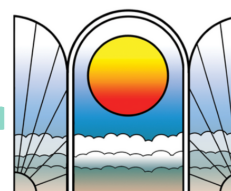
